

Non-Permissible activities in entire UT of J&K:

- 3) The following activities shall continue to remain prohibited across the entire Union Territory of J&K, irrespective of the categorization of the districts, w.e.f. 4th May, 2020, till further orders:
- (i) All domestic and international air travel of passengers, except for medical services, air ambulance, security purposes or for purposes as permitted by MHA.
 - (ii) All passenger movement by trains, except for security purposes or for purposes as permitted by MHA.
 - (iii) Inter-state, Inter-district and intra-district Buses for public transport and private vehicles, except for purposes permitted under this order in specific categories of districts.
 - (iv) All schools, colleges, universities, educational/ training/ coaching institutions, etc. However, online/distance learning shall be permitted.
 - (v) Hospitality services other than those used for housing health/ police/ Government officials/ healthcare workers, stranded persons, and those used for quarantine facilities.
 - (vi) All cinema halls, shopping malls, gymnasiums, sports complexes, swimming pools, entertainment parks, theatres, bars, liquor shops, restaurants, spas, saloons, parlours, barber shops and auditoriums, assembly halls and similar places, except where permitted under this order in specific categories of districts.
 - (vii) All social/ political/ sports/ entertainment/ academic/ cultural/ religious functions/ other gatherings.
 - (viii) All religious places/ places of worship shall be closed for public. Religious congregations are strictly prohibited.
 - (ix) The movement of individuals for all non-essential activities between 7 pm to 7 am. District Magistrates shall issue specific prohibitory orders in this regard under Section 144 of CrPC.
 - (x) Persons above 65 years of age, persons and with co-morbidities, pregnant women, and children below the age of 10 years, shall stay at home, except for meeting essential requirements or for health purposes.

Continuation of Activities already regulated in the UT of J&K:

The following Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) / guidelines/ instructions issued by the JK SDMA and JK SEC from time to time (available on the website – www.jkgad.nic.in) shall remain applicable in all the districts, except in the areas identified as the "Containment Zones":

- a. Standard Operating Procedure for Red zones (also known as Containment Zones) (Dated 14.04.2020).
- b. Standard Operating Procedure for regulating activities in construction sectors (Dated 16.04.2020).
- c. Standard Operating Procedure for select activities in rural areas (Dated 16.04.2020).
- d. Standard Operating Procedure for regulating industries, industrial/commercial/private establishments (Dated 17.04.2020).
- e. Standard Operating Procedure for issuance of movement passes (Dated 18.04.2020).
- f. Instructions on opening of shops in pursuance to MHA's Order No.40-3/2020-DM-I(A) (Dated 25.04.2020).
- g. Standard Operating Procedure for regulating the movement of migrant workers, stranded students and others (Dated 30.04.2020).
- h. Essential activities notified by the Food and Civil Supplies Department from time to time.

All activities permitted under the above Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) / guidelines/ instructions shall continue to be permitted in the UT of J&K., except in the areas identified as the "Containment Zones", and no fresh permissions would be needed except where fresh relaxations are being given under this order.

Additional activities permitted in Red Districts

Movement of individuals in vehicles is allowed only for permitted activities, with a maximum of 2 passengers, besides the driver in four wheeler vehicles, and with no pillion rider in case of two wheelers.

E-commerce activities (home delivery etc.) are permitted for essential services and goods.

Additional activities permitted in Orange Districts

Movement of individuals in vehicles is allowed for permitted activities, with a maximum of 2 passengers, besides the driver, in four wheeler vehicles, and with no pillion rider in case of two wheelers.

Intra-district movement of individuals in vehicles is allowed, with a maximum of 2 passengers, besides the driver, in four wheeler vehicles, and with no pillion rider in case of two wheelers, on the basis of passes issued by the concerned district authority.

Taxi and Cab aggregators are permitted to ply with one driver and two passenger only.

E-commerce activities (home delivery etc.) are permitted for essential services and goods.

Private offices can operate with upto 33% strength as per requirement with the remaining persons working from home.

Additional activities permitted in Green Districts:

All activities permitted in Orange Districts.

All shops in markets areas, except those prohibited in para 3 above.

Barber shops, spas and saloons

Buses can operate with upto 50% seating capacity on Intra-district routes and between contiguous Green districts.
