**Subject: Guidelines/instructions on lockdown measures in the Union Territory of Jammu & Kashmir –regarding.**

**Government Order No. 86 -JK (DMRRR) of 2020.**

**Dated: 30.10.2020**

- 1) Whereas, the Union Home Secretary in his capacity as Chairperson, National Executive Committee (NEC), vide Order No. 40-3/2020-DM-I(A) dated 27.10.2020, has issued guidelines for implementation of the extended lockdown in Containment Zones (Red Zones) till 30.11.2020 and continuation of unlock guidelines outside Containment Zones (Red Zones); and
- 2) As such, in exercise of powers conferred under Section 24 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, the State Executive Committee hereby orders that the guidelines/ instructions issued vide Order No.84 and 85-JK-(DMRRR) of 2020 dated 08.10.2020 shall continue to remain valid till 30.11.2020, subject to the following modifications in Order no. 85 – JK –(DMRRR) of 2020:
  - i. Instead of a ceiling of 7000 mentioned at para 3(ix), the upper limit for permissible number of pilgrims to SMVD Shrine, Katra, shall be 15000, w.e.f. 01.11.2020.
  - ii. The requirement for *travelers to undergo 14 day Home Quarantine* as mentioned at Para 6 shall be deleted.
- 3) All Other protocol / instructions shall continue to remain valid till 30.11.2020.
