#### Terms of Reference:

- i. To establish a hotline between the Chief Secretary, J&K, Director General of Police, J&K, and Director General, National Testing Agency.
- ii. To prepare an integrated strategy to break the nexus of paper leak mafia.
- iii. To prepare an exam-specific strategy for major examinations such as JEE, NEET, UGC-NET, CUET etc., to ensure fair, transparent, and zero error examination.
- iv. To issue specific briefings to the District level Committee(s) to prepare for such examinations.
- v. To ensure that District Level Committee(s) constituted are fully operational.

- vi. To review the performance of District Level Committee(s) after every major examination.
- vii. To submit a consolidated report based on observations and suggestions of District Level Committee(s) to the National Testing Agency for necessary action.

#### Terms of Reference:

- i. To identify suitable Testing Centres for the PPT and CBT after thoroughly scrutinizing the previous year's examinations conducted at these Testing Centres. Background analyses of the owners of prospective examination Centres, previous incidents of paper leaks, and inputs of the Intelligence Bureau/Local Intelligence Unit (LIU) shall be considered while suggesting the list.
- ii. To prepare a list of suspicious elements/miscreants and closely monitor their activities.
- iii. To ensure that the suggested list(s) of prospective Centres possess adequate infrastructure. A list of Centres with appropriate facilities for Persons with Disabilities shall be provided separately.
- iv. To prepare a strategy for safe transportation of question papers (in case of PPT) from the custodian to Testing Centres, under adequate security provided by the District Police and Paramilitary Forces.
