Terms of Reference:

- i. To devise a comprehensive roadmap for earthquake risk management and risk reduction in the UT of J&K.
- ii. To identify and define J&K's vulnerabilities to earthquakes, conducting detailed risk assessments to prioritize mitigation efforts and develop resilient sustainable strategies for earthquake preparedness and mitigation.
- iii. To chart out strategies for the screening and safety assessments of buildings for better insight into structural stability and safety in the wake of Earthquake risks.
- iv. To strengthen Earthquake preparedness through safety guidelines and key policy initiatives.
- v. To develop earthquake risk management strategies and focus on assessing the current state and challenges faced by J&K in earthquake preparedness and mitigation efforts.
- vi. To suggest the measures for earthquake preparedness and mitigation within the region.
- vii. To suggest on the measures for ensuring the safety of the population through measures like Public awareness, community engagement, capacity building and training.
- viii. To develop and implement earthquake-specific disaster management strategies at the UT and district levels, ensuring coordination among different departments, agencies and coordinating with other stakeholders.
 - ix. To suggest measures to prevent and mitigate the effects of earthquakes, such as building code enforcement, public awareness campaigns and earthquake resilient infrastructure.
 - x. To develop strategies for swift and effective response to earthquake events and Training & equipping government officials, emergency responders and community members with the skills and knowledge needed to effectively manage earthquake disasters.
