Subject:

Appointment of candidates to the J&K Police (Gazetted) Service and J&K Accounts (Gazetted) Service under direct recruitment quota through the Combined Competitive Examination, 2023-Change of service thereof.

Reference: Letter No.PSC/Exam/CCE(M)/2023/46 dated: 28.05.2025 from the J&K Public Service Commission.

Government Order No:841-JK(GAD) of 2025, Dated:02-07-2025.

WHEREAS, 75 posts were referred to the J&K Public Service Commission for making selection through Combined Competitive Examination-2023;

AND WHEREAS, consequent upon selection made on the basis of Combined Competitive Examination-2023, the general merit cum select list alongwith the allocation of service was forwarded in respect of 71 candidates for further necessary action as per following service wise breakup and recommendations in respect of 4 candidates was kept withheld by the Public Service Commission and it has been intimated that the same shall be sent separately.

Jammu and Kashmir Administrative Service: 24
J&K Police (Gazetted) Service: 24
J&K Accounts (Gazetted) Service: 23

AND WHEREAS, while forwarding the recommendations, the Public Service Commission conveyed that the three candidates, namely Mr. Gourav Tagotra, Ms. Mubina Akhtar Nag and Mr. Yasir Navid were to be allocated J&K Police service as per the merit-cum-preference. However, since they do not possess requisite physical standards, as such, were allotted J&K Accounts Service as per their third preference;

AND WHEREAS, Ms. Mubina Akhter Nag and Mr. Yasir Navid submitted medical certificates indicating that there may have been an error in the judgment of the First Medical Board and requested to allow appeal to a Second Medical Board;

AND WHEREAS, the matter was examined vis-à-vis regulation No. 11 (Appendix-IV) of SRO-103 of 2018 and the Competent Authority granted permission for an appeal to a Second Medical Board, as requested by both Ms. Mubina Akhter Nag and Mr. Yasir Navid. Consequently, the Jammu and Kashmir Public Service Commission was requested to refer the candidates to the Second Medical Board for re-examination and to provide the necessary recommendations as deemed appropriate;

AND WHEREAS, the J&K Public Service Commission vide communication No. PSC/Exam/CCE(M)/ 2023/46 dated 4.4.2025 intimated that as per the revised Medical Report received on 2.4.2025 from Principal, Government Medical College, Srinagar, Mr. Yasir Navid bearing Roll No. 9218499 has been declared fit for J&K Police Service. However, the case of Ms. Mubina Akhter Nag bearing Roll No. 9220547, was kept on hold due to ambiguity in the Medical Report;

AND WHEREAS, 70 candidates as per following service wise breakup have been appointed vide Government Order No. 527-JK(GAD) of 2025 dated 28.04.2025 and Government Order No. 528-JK(GAD) of 2025 dated 28.04.2025:

Junior JKAS = 24 Accounts = 22 Police = 24 **Total** = **70**

AND WHEREAS, appointment of Ms. Mubina Akhter Nag who was recommended for appointment to the J&K Accounts (Gazetted) Service was deferred for want of clarification from the Public Service Commission regarding her medical report;

AND WHEREAS, J&K Public Service Commission vide communication dated 28.05.2025 has intimated that ambiguity in Medical report of Ms. Mubina Akhter Nag has been removed by GMC Srinagar vide letter No. MS/SMHS/1728 date 24.05.2025 and she has been declared medically fit for allotment of J&K Police Service;

AND WHEREAS, the J&K Public Service Commission further intimated that Commission, in its 19th meeting held on 27.05.2025, has approved the following changes in allocation of services:

- Ms. Mubina Akhter Nag bearing Roll No. 9220547 (i) under RBA category shall figure at S .No.56 in Annexure- A of Letter No.PSC/Exam/CCE(M) /2023/46 dated:04.04.2025 and is allotted J&K Police Service instead of the earlier allotted J&K Accounts Service, as per her merit-cum-preference.
- above, the already the (ii) Consequent upon recommended candidate namely Mr. Shakir Hussain Malik Roll No. 9200382, under RBA Category, figuring at S.No.58 in Annexure-A of Letter No.PSC/Exam/CCE(M)/2023/46 dated:04.04.2025, is now allotted J&K Accounts Service instead of J&K Police Service.

NOW THEREFORE, in view of the recommendations of the J&K PSC, sanction is hereby accorded to change of service of Mr. Shakir Hussain Malik S/o Mohd Abass Malik R-7A Nowbough Kund Devsar District Kulgam, appointed vide Government Order No. 528-JK(GAD) of 2025 dated 28.04.2025, from J&K Police (G) Service to J&K Accounts (G) Service.

Consequent upon the above, Mr. Shakir Hussain Malik shall report to the Director General, Accounts and Treasuries, J&K for undergoing the prescribed training after completion of foundation course from J&K IMPA&RD. Rest of the terms and conditions of the appointment order issued vide 528-JK(GAD) of 2025 dated 28.04.2025 shall remain the same.

The appointment/allocation of the candidate to the Jammu and Kashmir Accounts (Gazetted) Service shall be subject to the outcome of the writ petition(s), if any, pending adjudication before any Competent Court of Law.
