**NOTIFICATION**

**Srinagar/Jammu, the \_\_\_\_\_ of \_\_\_\_\_ 2025**

**S.O. \_\_\_\_\_** In exercise of the powers conferred by Article 309 of Constitution of India and in supersession of all orders on the subject, the Lieutenant Governor, Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir is pleased to make the following rules:

**1. Short title and Commencement: (1)** These Rules shall be called "**the Jammu and Kashmir, Police (Subordinate) Service Recruitment Rules, 2025.**"

(2) These rules shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Government Gazette.

**2. Definitions.**—(1) In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires:-

a. “Administrative Department” means the Home Department of the Government in the Civil Secretariat holding the administrative charge of the Service;

b. “Appointing Authority” means the Authority as prescribed under the Jammu and Kashmir Police Rules, 1960.

c. “Cadre” means the cadre(s) of the Service;

d. “Competent Authority” means the Director General of Police, J&K.

e. “Government” means the Government of Union territory of Jammu and Kashmir;

f. “Member of the Service” means a person appointed to a post in the Service under the provisions of these rules or the orders superseded by these rules;

g. “Post” means a permanent post carrying a definite scale sanctioned by the Government;

h. “Rules” means the Jammu and Kashmir, Police (Subordinate) Service Recruitment Rules, 2025.

i. “Schedule” means the schedule(s) annexed to these rules;

j. “Service” means the Jammu and Kashmir Police (Subordinate) Service;

k. “Union Territory” means Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir.

(2) Words and expressions used in these rules but not defined shall have the same meaning as are assigned to them in the Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules 1956 and the Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services Regulations, 1956;

**3. Constitution of Service:** (1) From the date of commencement of these rules, there shall be constituted the “Jammu and Kashmir Police (Subordinate) Service”.

(2) The Government may, at the commencement of these rules, appoint to the service any person who at the commencement of these rules, is holding in substantive capacity any post included in the cadre(s) of this Service:

Provided that for the purpose of the initial constitution of the Service, a person holding any post included in the cadre(s) of the Service in its sanctioned scale of pay, in substantive capacity to which he was appointed by the appointing authority under rules, either by direct recruitment or by promotion shall be deemed to have been appointed to the Service under these rules.

**Explanation:-**The word ‘holding’ means a person holding a post included in the cadre(s) of the Jammu and Kashmir Police (Subordinate) Service in its sanctioned scale of pay on regular basis under orders of the appointing authority and will not include the persons holding a post on ex-cadre/deputation basis or on adhoc basis or in a stopgap arrangement.

**4. Strength and Composition of the Service.-**(1). The authorized permanent and temporary strength of the cadre(s) and the nature of the post included therein shall be determined by the Government from time to time and shall, at the initial

constitution of the Service under these rules, be such as specified in the **Schedule-I** annexed to these rules:

Provided that the Government may create temporary posts in the cadre of the Service for specified period or purpose as may be considered necessary from time to time.

(2) The Government shall, after the interval of every five years or at such other intervals, as may be necessary, re- examine the strength and composition of cadre(s) of the Service and make such alterations therein as it deems fit.

**(5) Cadre of the service:** - (1) The Jammu and Kashmir, Police (Subordinate) Service shall comprise the following Cadres:

1. General (Executive & Armed/ IR)
2. Telecommunication;
3. Ministerial Executive;
4. Stenography;
5. Photography; and
6. Police Transport Workshop;

**6. Qualification and method of Recruitment:-** (1) No person shall be eligible for appointment or promotion or induction to any post in any class, category or grade in the Service unless he/she possesses the qualification(s) as laid down in Schedule-II and fulfill other requirements, as provided in the orders for the time being in force.

(2) Appointment to the Service shall be made:

- (a) By direct recruitment; or
- (b) By promotion; or
- (c) By in-service induction; or
- (d) Partly by (a), and partly by (b), in the ratio, and in the manner, as mentioned against each post in Schedule-II:

Provided that all the posts under direct recruitment shall be filled through the Jammu and Kashmir Service Selection Board as per the notifications/orders of the Government issued for the purpose.

Provided further, that all posts to be filled by promotion shall be filled up through Departmental Promotion Committee (DPC), as prescribed in the Jammu and Kashmir Police Rules, 1960 (amended from time to time) or other orders/notifications issued from time to time by the Competent Authority. Further, the posts to be filled by in-service inductions shall be filled up through the Departmental Boards to be constituted for the purpose by the Competent Authority and such induction shall be made in accordance with the notifications and orders in force.

(3) The constitution of the DPC in respect of Subordinate cadre(s) shall be decided by the Competent Authority and the constitution of a Committee(s) shall include a representative from the Administrative Department.

(4) The Administrative Department and Police Headquarters shall respectively refer vacancies in the direct quota and promotion quota to Jammu and Kashmir Service Selection Board and Departmental Promotion Committee, as the case may be, in terms of SRO 166 dated: 14.06.2005.

**7. Probation:** Persons appointed to the service through direct recruitment, shall be on probation as provided in the Jammu and Kashmir Police Rules, 1960.

**8. Reservation in appointments:**

I. While making appointments either by direct recruitment or by promotion, reservation shall be provided to the eligible categories in accordance with the provisions of Jammu and Kashmir Reservation Act, 2004 and the rules and orders, as in force.

II. Horizontal Reservation of vacancies for SPOs/VHG's, Ex-agniveers, Women or any other category in appointments shall be provided as prescribed in The Jammu and Kashmir Police Rules, 1960 (amended from time to time) or other Rules as notified by the Government from time to time.

**9. Training and Departmental Examinations:** Persons appointed to the service shall be required to undergo such training from time to time during the course of probation and to pass such departmental examination(s) as prescribed in The Jammu and Kashmir Police Rules, 1960 or General Rules as notified from time to time:

**10. Maintenance of Seniority.**-(1) Seniority of the members of the service shall be regulated under the Jammu and Kashmir Police Rules, 1960, as notified from time to time.

(2) A Combined Seniority of all posts (Follower to Inspector) shall be maintained by the Police Headquarters, in case of Executive, Armed, and IR Battalions henceforth. Separateseniority for Telecommunication, Ministerial ExecutiveCadre, Stenography, Photography Cadre and PTWS Cadre, shall also be maintained by the same authority, as the case may be.

(3) The inter-se seniority of the probationer appointed to the service prior to the initial constitution of the service shall be determined in accordance with the Jammu and Kashmir Police Rules, 1960 or as notified from time to time, applicable on the date of their appointment to the service.

**11. Eligibility:**

(1) The eligibility of the candidates for appointment todifferent posts shall be determined as per the provisions of J&K Police Rules, 1960 as amended from time to time.

(2) A person already in the Service may apply through proper channel for direct recruitment to a vacant post in any particular class or category in the Service if he/she possesses the educational and other qualifications prescribed for recruitment to such class or category of posts and the upper age limit of such Government servants shall be as provided as per the Jammu and Kashmir Police Rules, 1960 (amended from time to time):

**12. Appointing Authority:** The appointing authority in Jammu and Kashmir Police (Subordinate) Service Recruitment Rules, 2025 shall be as defined in the Jammu and Kashmir Police Rules, 1960 (amended from time to time).

**13. Power to relax.-** Where the Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do so, it may by an order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of provisions of these rules with respect to any class, category of persons or post:

Provided that while exercising the discretion, the Government shall keep in view that the discretion is exercised in a bonafide manner.

**14. Residuary matters.-** In regard to matters not specifically covered by these rules, the members of the service shall be governed by the rules, regulations and orders applicable to the Civil Service of the Union Territory in general.

Provided that where Jammu and Kashmir Police (Subordinate) Service Recruitment Rules, 2025 rules are repugnant to any rules, regulations and orders applicable to the Civil Service of the Union Territory in general, these rules shall be followed.

**15. Interpretation.-** If any question arises relating to the interpretation of these rules, the decision of the Administrative Department, shall be final and binding.

**16. Repeal and Savings.** (1) All existing Orders relating to matters covered by these rules shall stand superseded from the date these rules come into force. The Orders in force immediately before the commencement of these rules are hereby repealed from the date(s) the corresponding provisions of these rules are enforced.

(2) Notwithstanding such repeal, any appointment or order made or action taken under the orders, so repealed, shall be deemed to have been made or taken under these rules.
